- 5. How important was the time-period or the setting to Sister Mother Warrior? What surprised you? Did the setting add to or distract from the story?
- 6. While the author, Vanessa Riley, tries to spare or limit the painful details, she felt it necessary to include certain painful scenes. What did you of the way violence was portrayed? What would you have left out? What needed more details?
- 7. Were there any quotes, sentences, or passages that stood out to you? Why?
- 8. What did you like most about the portrayal of Gran Toya? What did you like the least?

- 14. Overall, how did Sister Mother Warrior make you feel? Describe the emotions the story evoked?
- 15. What do you think Riley's goal was in writing this book? What ideas was she trying to illustrate?
- 16. Did your opinion of Sister Mother Warrior change as you read it? How?
- 17. Was the book satisfying to read? Why or why not?
- 18. If you could talk to the author, what burning question would you want to ask?
